# **COMPETITION CATEGORIES**

## **Business Idea**

You must have a profitable business concept that can exchange goods or services for payment.

# **Artisan Business**

You must have an existing skilled trades business with paying customers in the construction, plumbing, electrical, mechanical, or carpentry industries

## **Tech Business**

You must have an existing business with paying customers in the technology industry

#### **General Business**

You must have an existing business with paying customers that doesn't fall under the other categories.

### Participants entering an existing business must:

- Be the owner, founder, or controlling shareholder of the business entered.
- \* The business can only be represented by one person throughout the competition.
- Be the owner of the product or service offered.
- Be able to prove that they have generated income or received some form of investment at the time of entering.

# **REGISTRATION** *PROCESS*

#### Step 1

Register your entry by completing and submitting the entry form online.

### Step 2

Entries are reviewed and shortlisted by the competition coordinators at each TVET College. Confirmed participants will be invited to pitch their ideas or businesses in the internal college round.

#### Step 3

The winners of internal college rounds proceed to represent their institutions at regional rounds where they pitch to a panel of expert judges.

### Step 4

Winners of the regional rounds will be invited to pitch their idea or businesses at the National Finals.

# Step 5

Category winners & national TVET Studentpreneur of the year will be announced in Sept 2024.

Category winners walk away with R20 000 each and the runner ups in each category walk away with R10 000 each
